RE: Idaho Roadless Commission Pilot Project Results and Recommendations

Introduction

Idaho's Roadless Areas (IRA) make up the core of the last intact forest ecosystem in the lower 48 states where all native plants, fish, and wildlife can still be found, from the smallest plant to the largest predator. On September 20, 2006, then-Governor Risch petitioned the Secretary of Agriculture to promulgate a federal rule for managing 9.3 million acres of Roadless Areas in Idaho.

Following the State's participation in rulemaking, former Governor Risch promulgated Executive Order 2006-34, which established the Governor's Roadless Rule Implementation Commission. The Commission provides oversight and recommendations to the Governor to ensure the spirit and intent of the Rule are implemented and to facilitate a common understanding of the Rule. The Idaho Roadless Commission was codified in State law by the Legislature in 2018, as amended in 2020.

Background

In 2022, the Idaho Roadless Commission (IRRC) initiated a pilot project to answer multiple unresolved questions related to implementing and managing the Idaho Roadless Rule (IRR). One of those questions related to officially updating the total number of roadless acres after the 2015 designation of the Cecil D Andrus White Cloud Wilderness, the Hemingway-Boulder Wilderness, and the Jerry Peak – Jim McClure Wilderness areas.

The 2015 Wilderness legislation superseded the Boulder-White Cloud and Railroad Ridge Roadless area themes but did not precisely follow the boundaries of the pre-existing Roadless areas. The legislation should have included a provision to reconcile the Roadless acres taken out of the Statewide inventory because those acres are now designated Wilderness. Therefore, there was a standing question of how many acres were officially taken out of each theme, the new total, and what the designation means for the acres of Roadless that were left out of the wilderness and, in many cases, bisected by the new boundaries.

To maintain the integrity of the IRR, the Commission appointed a subcommittee to provide the FS with recommendations to resolve these questions. Almost a decade has passed since the 2015 legislation was passed, and the Roadless inventory still needs to be updated. Official management direction needs to be provided or documented regarding the leftover parcels of IRAs.

Methodology

Utilizing GIS data provided by the Forest Service, the subcommittee hired a third-party contractor to create a map overlaying the IRA's and the respective Wilderness boundaries. We determined which IRAs were involved, the total acres in the wilderness by theme, and what acres, per roadless area and theme, were left out of or were bisected by the Wilderness boundaries.

The analysis's results were captured in three Excel spreadsheets: one with all the un-summarized data (**Appendix A**), another with the summary of acres by theme *outside* the wilderness boundary (**Appendix B**), and a third table with the summary of acres by theme *inside* the Wilderness boundary (**Appendix C**). They are attached in Appendices **A, B, and C**, respectively. The final ArcGIS Story Map, which lays out the Roadless and Wilderness boundaries, is included in **Appendix D**. Object IDs were assigned to each parcel, inside and outside the Wilderness boundaries, regardless of size within the StoryMap.

Appendix B contains four data tables, 1A, 1B, and 1C, respectively. These add additional details to the other Appendices. The tables are sorted by the three wilderness areas, and all the parcels are displayed by theme outside the wilderness boundary, which is greater than 100 acres. **Table 1D** within **Appendix B** shows all the parcels by theme from zero to 0.01 acres and their respective Object code.

Decision Criteria and Options

As a footnote to the data tables:

- 1) The Commission suggests keeping the 100-acre cutoff practice outlined in the Roadless EIS for accountability and consistency. All parcels less than 100 acres would be removed from the inventory, and acreages adjusted accordingly.
- 2) Further, the Commission suggests, consistent with the provisions of the Wilderness Act of 1964, that even if a parcel is less than 5,000 acres, it still qualifies as Roadless if it is "of sufficient size to make practicable its preservation and use in an unimpaired condition" and is adjacent to designated Wilderness.

After analyzing the data and reviewing the outputs, the Commission supports updating the total number of acres and the number of acres by theme and managing the remaining parcels under 5,000 acres as Roadless. The Commission believes there are four options for the Forest Service to consider when documenting and adjusting Idaho's Roadless inventory by theme and endorses option three as articulated below.

Option 1: No Action

Continue with the current practice of having outdated Roadless acres and theme numbers, which will leave an administrative question over the acres surrounding the 2015 Wilderness Designations.

Option 2: Use Modification and Clarification, Formal Rulemaking

The forests and regions cannot directly change the designated boundaries of IRAs through a plan revisions or otherwise. The Rule provides a process for mapping administrative corrections and modifications: however, the authority to make changes is reserved to the Chief and must undergo public comment.

Administrative corrections: "...include, but are not limited to, adjustments that remedy clerical errors, typographical errors, mapping errors, or improvements in mapping technology." A 30-day public notice and opportunity to comment is required for all corrections 36 CFR 294.27(a)

Modifications: "...The Chief may add to, remove from, or modify the designations and management classifications listed in CFR 294.29 based on changed circumstances or public need..." The Chief shall provide at least a 45-day public notice and opportunity to comment for all modifications". 36 CFR 294.27 (b)

The Forest Service process for making modifications and administrative corrections to IRAs was updated in 2016.

Option 3: Administrative Documentation

The Forest Service develops and promulgates an official letter to document the inventory corrections by theme and management direction inside and outside the 2015 Wilderness boundaries.

Option 4: Legislative Option

Working with the Idaho Congressional Delegation, develop legislation that includes the corrections, acre adjustments, and management direction for parcels by theme inside and outside the 2015 Wilderness boundaries.

The integrity and longevity of the Idaho Roadless Rule depends on an accurate accounting of the total acres by theme of roadless lands in the State of Idaho. Overlapping management layers on the same parcel of land can confuse land managers and stakeholders, complicating land management planning and stalling NEPA decision-making. A precise inventory of roadless acres remaining outside federally protected Wilderness, along with the management direction of these parcels, will help avoid needless litigation while setting realistic expectations for treatment scenarios on these lands. Over the past two years, the Idaho Roadless Commission has diligently identified and documented an accurate accounting of roadless lands in Central Idaho. We formally submit this data to the Forest Service requesting that the inventory be updated; and that **Option 3** be considered to resolve these questions.

On behalf of the entire Idaho Roadless Commission, it is a pleasure to serve the Governor and the people of Idaho in the stewardship of our critical roadless lands.
